### TOTAL AMOUNT DISTRIBUTED

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the 30-day Report and every 45 days thereafter). As of March 31, 2021, Concorde at its 16 campuses in 8 states had distributed **\$9,987,568** in Emergency Financial Aid Grant.

# STUDENTS RECEIVING EMERGENCY FINANCIAL AID GRANTS

The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 314(a)(4) of the CRRSAA Act.

HEERF II Grant amounts were determined based each student's EFC according to their FAFSA and on eligible enrollment dates as of February 2021. Eligible students across all locations totaled **7,261**. To ensure every eligible student did receive aide, the amount awarded to each location was divided by the eligible students for that location to provide one amount per student.
